-  Frequently misdiagnosed or diagnosed late

Many patients face recurrence or metastatic disease

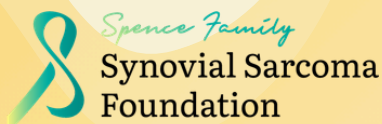
Rare cancers often receive less funding and fewer treatment options

No One Fights Synovial Sarcoma Alone.

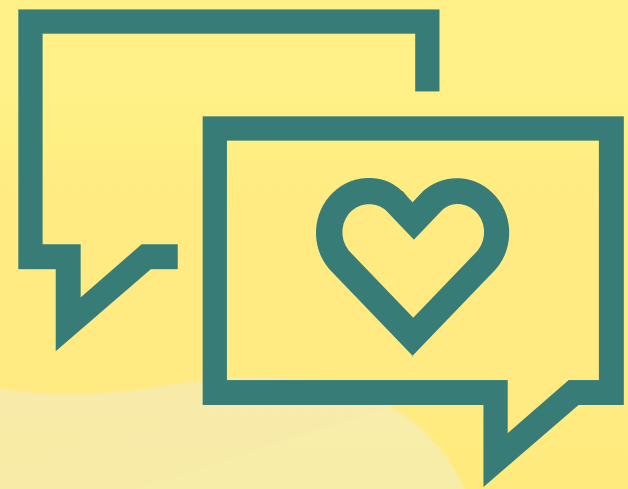
